About U.S. 30 Improvements

U.S. 30, Topaz to Lava Hot Springs Project

The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) widened three miles of U.S. 30 west of Lava Hot Springs to four lanes. This project was the first to be funded with Grant Anticipation Revenue Vehicle (GARVEE) bonds, which allow the state to accelerate highway improvements.

U.S. 30, Portneuf River Bridges Project

ITD will begin widening 1.9 miles of U.S. 30 to four lanes and replace existing culverts with two new bridges over the Portneuf River this fall.
